Prayer Journal

Purpose: The purpose of this journal is to help your prayer life become more effective by organization. I Corinthians 14:40 tells us “*Let all things be done decently and in order.*” and that includes prayer. Prayer is an individual thing, everyone will use this tool a little differently, do what ever works for you. As you get started let me make a few suggestions.

- 1) Set a time to pray. Success does not happen by accident, it happens on purpose. To be successful in your prayer life you should set a time and stick to it.
- 2) Find a solitary place where there will be no distractions.
- 3) Keep your prayer journal where you will see it. This will remind you to pray.
- 4) Be Specific with your prayer. Don't ask *God, help John* but rather *God, help John find a Job.*
- 5) Be sure to mark prayers that have been answered, this will be a great source of encouragement.
- 6) Be consistent, make prayer a habit not a happening.
